In late 2013, the Avett Brothers released their eighth album, Magpie and the Dandelion. If you are unfamiliar, they are moreor-less a folk-rock band using traditional stringed instruments like banjo, acoustic guitar, double bass, and cello. Some tracks are augmented by drums, piano, and organ.

Producer Rick Rubin, with a resume that stretches wide from the Beastie Boys, Slayer, and Johnny Cash, has been on board for the band's last three records, and has helped them develop a mature signature sound that recalls mellow bluegrass, Beatleesque melodies and harmonies, and 90's rock.

2012's The Carpenter was recorded during the same sessions. With both releases sharing the same tones and same studio friends, the two records make for a great back-to-back listen. Go for the trifecta and add 2009's I and Love and You to the playlist. Let me know what you think!

Slow Cooker Ham and Scalloped Potatoes

What you need:

2 cups ham, cooked and diced 10 medium potatoes, peeled and sliced thin 1 large onion, sliced thin 10 - 3/4 oz. can cream of mushroom soup 1 1/2 cups sharp cheddar cheese, shredded 4 oz. can mushrooms, sliced and drained 1/4 tsp pepper 1/4 tsp salt

What you do:

Place all ingredients in a 3.5 quart or larger slow cooker and mix well. Cook covered for 8 hours on low, or until potatoes are to desired consistency.
