From me and my family, let me wish each and every one of you a very Happy Thanksgiving!

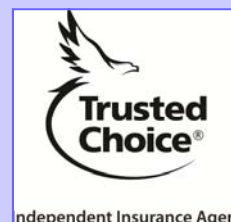

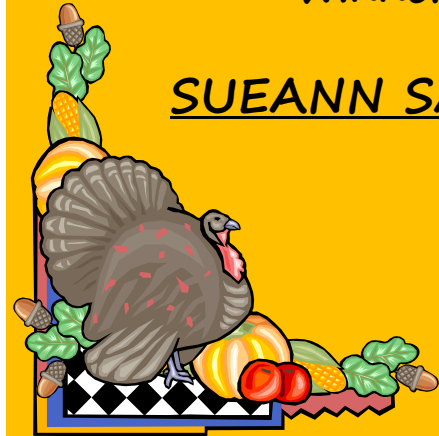

Ingredients

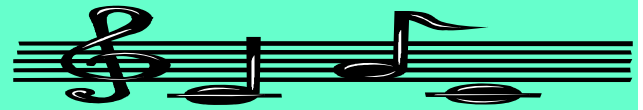
- 6 ounces dry bread stuffing mix
- 10 slices day-old bread, torn in small bits
- 3 eggs, beaten
- 1/2 cup of chicken broth



Directions

- Preheat oven to 350°
- Butter or spray 2 quart casserole dish
- Prepare stuffing mix according to directions on box; place stuffing in a large bowl
- Add the dried bread, eggs & water; mix well and place in casserole dish
- Cover and bake 45 to 60 minutes

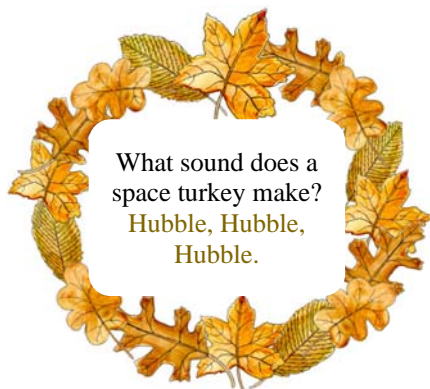
